There are two kinds of IP to consider for this inventory:

1. "**Device-like software**," defined as software that is intended primarily and is reasonably likely to accomplish a task or to produce, manage, analyze, or manipulate a product, such as data text, a physical object, or more software. Such software acts as a tool or building block in the accomplishment of such a task or in the creation or management of such a product or result.
2. "**Institutional works**," defined as works created at the instigation of the University, under the specific direction of the University, for the University's use, by a person acting within the scope of his or her employment or subject to a written contract.
