

Selected Instructions for Completing the Software Disclosure Form

The purpose of this Software Disclosure is to record what was created and the circumstances under which it was created. Software may be subject to copyright and patent protection, and accurate information is critical to assessing appropriate means and availability of protection. It is a legally important document, which should be prepared carefully.

- Item 1.** Provide a short and descriptive title. This title will be posted on the IURTC website and may be shared with others to market the Software. Please take care to choose a title that does not disclose novel, unpublished, aspects of the Software.
- Item 2.** Provide a two or three sentence description of the Software. This information is required for reporting the Software to the federal government and other sponsors.
- Item 3.** **This information will be necessary for establishing creatorship. Maintain all original notes, drawings, data or other writings pertinent to the Software.** Provide information regarding the date each event occurred, the type of supporting material documenting the event and its location for:
- Conception of the Software
 - Where the work was performed
 - Reduction to practice in an operational sense
- Item 8.** List all sponsors whose funds in any amount have been used for any purpose related to the Software. For each sponsor, also provide the grant number, principal investigator listed on that grant and an estimate of the relative contribution. The Federal government and other funding agencies require reporting of patentable Software made with their funds. This information is needed by IURTC to comply with those requirements.
- Item 9.** Public disclosure is the date when Software (or description of the Software) is first available or accessible to the public. Public disclosure may take place any of the following forms among others: journal article, conference abstract, news releases, dissertations, poster presentation, web pages (including those of a journal publisher), published grant applications, oral presentation, seminars outside IU or discussions with non-IU personnel who are not under confidentiality restrictions.
- Item 13.** Does it include other software, code, or programming; or may it otherwise be subject to the rights of others in pre-existing material (s) or inventions? Are any portions of it "shareware", "freeware", "open source", or subject to other licenses from third parties?
- Item 20.** Are these plans in progress? Scheduled? Are these plans dependent upon commercial or federal sponsorship?
